- 4) Willingness and ability in proactive engagements in the planning and management of key projects in our graduate school, especially with the Hyogo Prefectural Awaji Landscape Planning and Horticulture Academy.
- 5) Agree with ‘fixed term appointment’ (Refer next chapter)
- 6) High level of Japanese language proficiency. Ability to teach lectures and lead exercises in Japanese, and have communication skills in Japanese that will enable them to smoothly carry out their duties within the university and support volunteer group activities, while respecting organizational management rules and human relations.
